


Casual Day and Hamper Donation Day

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Preschool: *Baby and Toddler*, suggestions include; new baby clothes, toys, books, accessories like baby bottles, nappies, nursery items, anything you would need for baby or you think a toddler would enjoy. **(Please no perishable foods)**



Reception and Year 1: *Craft and Stationary*, items your children can be creative with. Suggestions include; writing paraphernalia, colouring in books, stickers, pens, pencils, texters, canvases, paints, writing materials, art and craft items, sequins, pop sticks, glitter, stationary.



Year 2 and 3: *Homewares*, anything for to make inside and outside your home beautiful including your children’s bedrooms. Suggestions include; candles, photo frames, coffee/tea cups, serving tray, artwork, outdoor pots, table decorations; think of anything you would like to see in your home.



Year 4: *Baking/ Cooking*, anything you would use in the kitchen. Suggestions include baking trays, muffin tins, kitchen utensils, mixing bowls, cookbooks, tea towels, aprons.



Year 5, Year 6 and Year 7: *Games/ Sports/ Gardens*, anything you’d find in the shed or backyard and games to keep you busy on rainy days or to be played in the backyard. Suggestions include; gardening items, tools, backyard accessories, board games, totem tennis, pool toys, cards games, basketballs, netballs, soccer balls, footballs, pop up goals, skipping ropes, hula hoops.
