It is a pathway to deeper prayer, good decisions guided by active discernment and a life of service to others.

Ignatian Spirituality is:

- A spirituality of the heart and not just the mind, of generosity and openness
- A spirituality of seeking and being prepared and ready to resist in difficult situations
- A spirituality that is both contemplative and active
- A spirituality that facilitates intimate encounters with God

Ignatian spirituality encourages us to...

- * Find and recognise God in all things and develop a personal relationship with God
- * Live a life of reflection leading to gratitude and a life of service for others
- * Live a life of contemplation in action, one that is both active and prayerful
- * Live life according to the maxim 'For The Greater Glory of God'
- * Translate our faith into working for justice and human dignity
- * Be flexible and adaptable to various cultures: respecting others lived experience
- * Seek the union of minds and hearts - as sisters and brothers, we listen for the God who is present among us, with no division based on ethnicity, nationality, background, age or gender
