This information is crucial to the planning and coordination of buses for the day, please ensure it is completed by Thursday 23 September as changes cannot be made after this date. Students arrive at school (both William and Bridge Street) by 8:30am when the bell will sound. Students go to class where the role will be taken and then students will be bussed to the venue from 8:45am. At the conclusion of the carnival (approximately 2:15pm) students can leave directly from the venue with their parent/caregiver (after being signed out through their class teacher), or be bussed back to their school site for normal pick up or OSHC.

Wear:	House colour t-shirt (no singlets – as per Sun Protection Policy, t-shirts must have sleeves), school shorts and sneakers.
