Any content that includes inappropriate language, defamatory statements, election campaign materials or is otherwise deemed inappropriate will be deleted by page administrators.

Identifiable images of students and surnames will not be published or tagged on this page by administrators without parent consent.

We ask that users of this page endeavour to follow the practices of administrators in their engagement with this page.

The group is administered by P&F Executive members.

The group has been assigned as 'private' status: all activity is only viewable and editable by group members.

Here are some guidelines relating to appropriate use of the group:

- To avoid clutter, please ONLY POST MATERIAL which relates to the activities of our school and P&F association;
- Please DO NOT POST ANY PHOTOGRAPHS OF STUDENTS within the group. We would like to avoid any issues which might arise from unauthorized photo viewing and sharing;
- Please DO NOT POST ANY CONTENT THAT IS NEGATIVE OR INAPPROPRIATE IN NATURE within the group. We would like to avoid any issues which might arise from such unauthorized comments (if you have a grievance or feedback for the school, please email info@sjms.catholic.edu.au, this fb page is not the forum for such information);
- Second hand uniforms may be advertised on this page with the respondents private messaging the seller.
- Although the group is private, please use language and content appropriate for a general, G-rated audience;
- If you are concerned about the use of Facebook for our school P&F, please raise it with a member of our executive or email the address above;
- Page administrators reserve the right to remove members not abiding by the items in our code of conduct;
- This group is shared and belongs to all of us. Please contribute ideas and initiate conversations whenever you can!

- Please give us a bit of information about yourself when you have the chance;
